

my goal was to play with stamping to emphasize the notion that what unfolds in the book is destined to repeat, like a loop.















black, red on 240g paper, illustrations made with stamps and acrylic paint.






the goal is to convey the energy of the show by playing with movements blur and contrasts. thanks to those settings we can relive through the pics the exhilaration of the show.






géovélo app, [ui/ux]




as an introduction to figma, i redesigned the géovélo app.
